Lincoln at Gettysburg

Lincoln at Gettysburg was written to commemorate the 150th anniversary of Abraham Lincoln's *Gettysburg Address*, certainly one of the most eminent and familiar speeches in American history. The piece combines a descriptive narration with an accompanying original musical score. It begins in a somber and reflective mood conveying Lincoln's own deep sense of sadness over the catastrophic loss of life in the battle - over 51,000 soldiers - that engulfed the small Pennsylvania village the previous July. Themes borrowed from several famous Civil War-era songs are heard, including "Kingdom Coming" by Henry C. Work and "Just Before the Battle, Mother," a poignant parlor song by George F. Root. As the piece builds to a patriotic finale, additional melodies join in, first from the marching tune "The Battle Cry of Freedom" - also by George F. Root - and finally "The Battle Hymn of the Republic" by William Steffe. The piece conveys Lincoln's successful struggle to find words that would reassure a grieving nation, and would live on to inspire and unify generations of Americans to follow.
